
















Medical Campaigns to Combat Blindness and Treat Eye Diseases

Over 2,025 individuals received medical services through specialized eye clinics. The campaign included comprehensive eye exams and 504 successful cataract surgeries. Patients also received free prescription glasses, lenses, and medications.

The drilling of artesian and shallow wells provides clean water to vulnerable and remote communities, contributing to the strengthening of local water sources. Altwasul follows best humanitarian practices by incorporating renewable energy into its water projects, ensuring sustainability and environmental responsibility.









Water Network

Extension Projects

These projects aim to serve families and surrounding villages in rural and underserved areas. The interventions include the installation of submersible pumps, the construction of elevated tanks, and the extension of piped water networks, ensuring reliable access to safe drinking water directly to homes and community distribution points. This approach reduces water-fetching burdens, particularly for women and children, and enhances the overall well-being and living conditions of the targeted communities.


