



### Health >

Altwasul interventions in health sector contribute to the recovery of this sector, strengthen its capabilities and improve its services, which contributes to achieving the goals of sustainable development and raising the level of community health.



The specialized hospital for motherhood and childhood consists of three floors, in addition to a basement and facilities. The first floor contains the general emergency department, specialized clinics, a laboratory and a pharmacy. The second floor prepared for inpatients, besides the hospital management rooms. The third floor contains

the operations dept., ICU, the lactation room, the neonatal room and delivery department. The facility building contains the doctors' room, sterilization rooms and the laundry, in addition to a basement containing the radiology department, hospital stores and a meeting room.

The hospital was built and equipped with the latest medical equipment and devices with a capacity of  $\frac{20}{100}$  medical beds for annually  $\frac{3,000}{100}$  beneficiaries (the mother and the child).



### Shelter>

Altwasul interventions in shelter sector contributed to improving the conditions of IDP. These interventions devoted effort to provide valuable humanitarian action which actually marked by improvement, development and innovation, taking into account securing a decent life and adequate housing for the IDPs. In an unprecedented endeavor, IDPs at the residential villages were able to address their concerns and create new solutions that contributed directly to more sustainable solutions...

#### **Opening of Mansour Al-Khulaifi Residential Village - Marib**

The great village of Mansour Al-Khulaifi was opened to shelter IDPs in Marib Governorate. The village contains 60 housing units supplied with water tanks and a water network, as well as building and equipping of a mosque, in addition to a 30-meter well with a tower tank,

### Almost 8,140 beneficiaries of the relief of those affected by the floods of Al Maharah (Teej)

Altwasul intervention in Al-Mahra Governorate came as a rapid response to the humanitarian appeal requested by the local authority for the relief of those affected by Tropical Storm (Teej). 300 shelter kits consisting of mattresses and blankets in addition to basic kitchen appliances were distributed. The project also included the distribution of 6,000 hot food meals and 20,000 bottles of drinking water.



Food baskets project, through our interventions in food sector, contributed to providing food security for IDPs and affected people in conflict areas.








Distribution of food baskets among the most vulnerable households: 6,998 households have benefited from this project.

# Building a primary education school in Aden

through the great support of the General Secretariat of Awqaf in the State of Kuwait, and within the "Kuwait is on your side" campaign and to enhance the educational process in Yemen, a model primary education school was built and equipped in Aden Governorate. The school consists of 81 classrooms, administration rooms, a laboratory, and bathrooms, allowing 1,036 male and female students to benefit from this school. The purpose of building this school is strengthen and improve the infrastructure for the educational process in Aden Governorate and reduce crowding in schools

#### **Children Psychological Support Project**

We, at Altwasul for Human Development, pursue to provide psychological support for the children who have no breadwinner. This can be done through various programs of educational and entertainment activities and provision of child-friendly spaces for purpose of building their capacities, developing their skills, strengthening the social relationship, enhancing the child confidence and emotional connection of children within the governorates of Aden, Taiz, Sana 'a, Marib and Hadhramaut.





#### **Construction of Edris Model School**



In response to urgent educational needs and within the framework of cooperation and partnership with the government sector represented by the Ministry of Education, " Altwasul for Human Development" has built and equipped Edris Model School, which includes 21 classrooms, a laboratory, and administration and educational facilities with a capacity of 024 students. The project contributes to meeting the increasing need for classrooms and school facilities to accommodate the number of students due to the increasing waves of displacement in Marib Governorate.






### Livelihood Improvement Project (9 Cargo Electric Trike) 64 beneficiaries
