

In 2021, we worked on multiple fronts in the campaign to end malnutrition, focusing on children under the age of five and pregnant and lactating women suffering from acute malnutrition. We provided integrated primary health care, therapeutic nutrition, nutritional support, and nutritional and health counseling in 5 Yemeni governorates (Aden, Taiz, Abyan, Hadhramaut and Hodeida).





Education is a key priority in our strategy for humanitarian interventions and programs because our goal is to uplift people.


